a. School Initiative: General School Information: 67 enrolled students in K-9; Additional 7 students enrolled in JK; 8 teachers on staff; 2 educational assistants; 2 wellness workers (FSLW and Wellness Coach)

Full Time Kindergarten:7 out of 8 students enrolled in full time; 2 students utilizing transportation to and from daycare

Hockey Program: 9 enrolled in the 4-6 program; 7 enrolled in the 7-9 program; Ice will be available first week of October due to problem with plant Junior Kindergarten Transportation: 3, but potentially 4 students utilizing transportation to and from daycare
