Standing Items:Principal's Report: This year has 78 enrolled students in K-9, Additional 9 students enrolled in JK, 7 teachers on staff, 1 student teacher until end of December, 4 educational assistants, 2 wellness workers (FSLW and Wellness Coach). 7 out of 10 students enrolled in full time kindergarten. 5 JK students and none from K utilize **transportation to and from daycare**. **Hockey Program:** 2 enrolled in the 4-6 program so we had to cancel this year. 8 enrolled in the 7-9 program so we moved to one ice time a week instead of two. Ice will be available last week of September. One student utilizes Alliance Bus to get to GW's **After School Care Program**. We welcomed back students September 2. Parent Council hosted a "**Welcome Back BBQ**" on September 4 for all TCS families. **Volleyball Season:** All 5-9 students have the opportunity to play. League games on Wednesdays with many tournament opportunities this year. The season ends middle of November. **X-Country Season:** All 3-9 students invited to join with 2-4 meets throughout the season which ends middle of October. **Upcoming Events:** Jeremy Allen will have a Presentation-Death Ed Sept. 17, with K-9s during the school day and a parent session 7pm. TCS Boys and Girls Volleyball Tournament on September 20, Awards Night on September 23 at 6:30pm. The Terry Fox Run is at TCS this year on September 25. We will recognize National Truth and Reconciliation Day (Sept 30) on Sept. 26, with a special presentation and activities done throughout the day; all students are invited to wear orange shirts.
