a. Grant Applications: Miss Hepp will soon submit two grant applications to the Community Enhancement Fund. The first, through the Waste Management Fund, is for \$2500 for new sports equipment. The second is for \$5000 for an outdoor classroom through the Wind Fund.

b. Fine Arts Night is on May 28th in the evening. It will showcase all classes through art, music, and drama.

c. Town Water Issue: boil water advisory; water fountains are tapped off, and sanitizer is provided. Drinking water is available, though children are encouraged to bring enough of their own from home. If the water is shut off for more than 1hr kids will be sent home.

d. School Registration Open: A new program, School Engage, will be used from now on. It is user-friendly, and an email was sent out with instructions. It should create less work for the school secretary.

e. Vandalism on Buses: The school will be installing security cameras on the outside of the building to help deter or catch vandals. They are also looking into a chainlink fence for further safety.
